

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City of Rio Dell is pleased to announce the upcoming Eel River Riparian Recreation Trail!

We aim to provide citizens and visitors a place to walk or bike along the river, and to rehabilitate an area prone to misuse. The trail will be a non-motorized, paved trail along the lovely Eel River and will be accessible from multiple places in town.

This project will be transformative for the community and restorative for our local riparian ecosystem. The trail will provide passive education on many topics, including environmental protection and the importance of proper trash disposal, as well as local Native American history and the role of railroads and logging in the Eel River Valley.

The Eel River Trail will eventually serve as a spur of the Great California Trail and showcase the beautiful scenery Rio Dell and Humboldt County provide. The City of Rio Dell is deeply appreciative to have received Clean California grant funds to complete this project and would like to thank Governor Gavin Newsom, as well as local community members who showed overwhelming support!
