The Manchester Band of Pomo Indians has many areas that require clean-up and removal of waste that consist of anything from typical trash to abandoned vehicles left on the roadway.

Our aim is to reduce the amount of waste and debris by using the existing tribal groundskeeping crew and a local waste removal service to gather and dispose of the waste.

After the garbage has been cleared, we plan on decreasing the amount of overgrown vegetation which will provide a healthier, greener environment; as well as provide the community with improved spaces for transit, walking and recreation.

Revitalization of our community playground will also take place.
