CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZATION PROCEDURES AND ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA FOR NEW NOISE/SOUND BARRIERS



The Department is accepting submittals for New Noise/Sound Barriers for use on the State Highway. The following procedures are required to authorize a New Noise/Sound Barrier product for inclusion on the New Noise/Sound Barrier Authorized Materials List (AML):

- 1. Manufacturer/Supplier/Vendor shall:
 - Complete the Noise/Sound Barrier Product Submittal Sheet.
 - Submit Required Testing.
 - Send a 12" x 12" sample of the product to: California Department of Transportation

- 2. Caltrans will evaluate the submittal as follows:
 - Ensure all required documents and sample are received.
 - Review the technical information provided.
 - Inform manufacturer/supplier/vendor in writing of the evaluation results.
 - Update the Noise/Sound Barrier Authorized Materials List as necessary.
- 3. Authorization of the Noise/Sound Barrier will expire in 10 years.
- 4. To renew, Manufacturer/Supplier/Vendor should submit their package with current information approximately 6 months prior to expiration.
- 5. Caltrans reserves the right to sample and/or remove a product from the AML at any time.
