Public Transportation Modernization, Improvement, and Service Enhancement Account Program Annual Legislative Report—Fiscal Year 2018-19



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Report to the Legislature 2019

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Executive Summary

The Public Transportation Modernization, Improvement, and Service Enhancement Account (PTMISEA) program is among the programs created by the passage of Proposition 1B, the Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality, and Port Security Bond Act of 2006. The PTMISEA program is designed to help advance the State's policy goals of providing mobility choices for all residents, reducing congestion, and protecting the environment.

State general obligation bond law (Government Code section 16724.4) requires a bond-funded program's administrative agency to submit a report on the status of the program to the California State Legislature by January 1 each year.

Proposition 1B made \$19.925 billion in funds available for transportation, \$4 billion of which is designated for the PTMISEA program to the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for intercity rail projects and for commuter or urban rail operators; bus operators; waterborne transit operators; or other transit operators. The \$4 billion is split into two sub programs: \$400 million to the Intercity Rail Improvement Program and \$3.6 billion to the Mass Transportation Program, for local transit projects.

Proposition 1B provided legislative intent that the overall \$19.925 billion program would fund mobility, safety, and air quality improvements over the course of a decade–through 2018. As of the date of this report, approximately \$3.945 billion of PTMISEA program funds have been allocated to projects. About \$55 million for the Intercity Rail Improvement program remains to be allocated for construction of programmed projects. These funds are programmed for the construction phase of projects currently undergoing pre-construction activities, such as environmental clearance or design. Caltrans staff will continue working closely with project sponsors to ensure these projects are allocated and delivered timely.

The 2018 Budget Act (SB 840, Mitchell, Chapter 29, Statutes of 2018) re-appropriated the remaining PTMISEA program funds for local transit and the Intercity Rail Improvement Program, extending the allocation deadline for the two programs until June 30, 2019, and June 30, 2020, respectively. The last allocation of local transit funds was made in April 2019. These projects have until June 30, 2023, for completion.

Background

Statutory Reference and Purpose

Government Code section 16724.4 (see Appendix A)

State general obligation bond law requires a bond-funded program's administrative agency to submit a report on the status of the program to the California State Legislature by January 1 each year, including the following information:

- A list of all projects and their geographical location that have been funded or are required or authorized to receive funds.
- The amount of funds allocated on each project.
- The status of any project required or authorized to be funded.

Program Background

The PTMISEA program is among the programs created by Proposition 1B, the Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality, and Port Security Bond Act of 2006. Government Code section 8879.50 (SB 88, Committee on Budget and Fiscal Review, Chapter 181, Statutes of 2007) identifies Caltrans as the administrative agency of the PTMISEA program and defines Caltrans' duties and responsibilities.

Proposition 1B provides that it is the intent of the Legislature to fund mobility, safety, and air quality improvements. The PTMISEA program is designed to advance the State's policy goals of providing mobility choices for all residents, reducing congestion, and protecting the environment.

Proposition 1B made \$19.925 billion available for transportation, \$4 billion of which is designated to the PTMISEA program. Out of this \$4 billion, \$3.6 billion is dedicated to transit rehabilitation; safety; modernization improvements; capital service enhancements or expansions; new capital projects; bus rapid transit improvements; and rolling stock procurement, rehabilitation, or replacement. The remaining \$400 million is dedicated to intercity rail projects and commuter or urban rail operators, administered under the Intercity Rail Improvement Program.

To date, all of the \$4 billion has been programmed for projects. Of that, approximately \$3.945 billion has been allocated to more than 1,300 projects. The 2018 Budget Act (SB 840, Mitchell, Chapter 29, Statutes of 2018) re-appropriated the remaining PTMISEA program funds for local transit and the Intercity Rail Improvement Program, extending the allocation deadline for the two programs until June 30, 2019, and June 30, 2020, respectively. The last allocation of local transit funds was made April 2019. These projects have until June 30, 2023, for

completion. The \$55 million remaining to be allocated is programmed to fund the construction phase of projects in the Intercity Rail Improvement Program. These projects are currently undergoing pre-construction activities, such as environmental clearance or design. These funds will be allocated for construction in the future.

Key Terms

Programming is the commitment to fund a project.

An allocation is a distribution of funds to a project.

Program Status/Program Accomplishments

Mass Transportation Program Proposition 1B Bond Fund

The PTMISEA program designates \$3.6 billion to transit operators for local transit projects. Caltrans developed the program guidelines through a cooperative effort with 180 local agencies and transit operators eligible to receive program funding. The guidelines established that PTMISEA funds may be used only for transit projects that include:

- Rehabilitation, safety, or modernization improvements.
- Capital service enhancements or expansions.
- New capital projects.
- Bus rapid transit improvements.
- Rolling stock procurement, rehabilitation, or replacement.

To date, \$3.6 billion has been allocated to approximately 1,300 projects through the local transit element of the PTMISEA program and 1,000 projects have been completed. Of these completed projects, 30 percent reported an increase in ridership, 30 percent reported an increase in system reliability, 10 percent reported a reduction in emissions, and 30 percent reported a reduction in operating or maintenance costs.

The most recent allocation of PTMISEA funds was made in April 2019. All projects have until June 30, 2023, to be completed. The program currently manages and monitors more than 350 open local transit projects.

As many of the projects are multi-year projects, Caltrans anticipates continuing to closely monitor these projects until all are completed as approved and recording benefits and outcomes to ensure compliance. This includes the administration and monitoring of additional projects expected to be created by amendments, corrective plans, and the transference of PTMISEA funds from existing projects that have identified cost savings, ensuring funds are expended in accordance with legislation, regulations, and requirements.

Appendix B lists all local transit projects that have received an allocation of funds. This list includes the name of the project, the amount allocated, and the status of the project reported as the percentage completed.

The following five completed PTMISEA projects exemplify the range in scope of local transit projects funded by the program:

- Warm Springs Extension—\$37 million: Extend the San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit System Fremont Line by adding 5.4 miles of trackway and a station in the Warm Springs district of Fremont. Ridership exits indicate a two percent increase in ridership.
- Tahoe City Transit Center-\$390,000: Design and construction of a 30-year-plus facility to accommodate ridership increase. This multi-modal facility provides interior and exterior waiting areas; restrooms; vehicle parking; bike lockers; bus arrival information; and bus and locker pass vending machines.
- City of Tehachapi Bus Stop Enhancements—\$90,000: Expand a single bus shelter into a park and ride transit center with bus turnouts, bus shelters, approximately 100 parking spaces, lighting, kiosk, and benches in the City of Tehachapi.
- San Fernando Valley Extension North/South Bus Rapid Transit—\$70 million: Extend the Metro Bus Rapid Transit Orange-Line by four miles. The alignment connects the Metrolink trains to the north and Warner Center business district to the south. Ridership exits indicate a 16-percent increase in ridership
- City of Gardena Purchase Two Electric Buses-\$1.4 million: Purchase of two 40-foot replacement buses for an aging fleet. Project has resulted in a 74-percent reduction in operating cost and 100 percent reduction in emissions.

Intercity Rail Improvement Program Proposition 1B Bond Fund

The Intercity Rail Improvement program accounts for \$400 million of the \$4 billion PTMISEA program. In December 2007 the California Transportation Commission approved the PTMISEA guidelines for Intercity Rail Improvement projects and subsequently approved the list of projects in February 2008. The California Transportation Commission requires a minimum of \$125 million from the Intercity Rail Improvement program to be designated for procurement of additional intercity passenger railcars and locomotives.

To date, \$340 million has been allocated to 26 projects, of which 15 projects, totaling \$145 million, have been completed and another 11 projects, totaling \$196 million, are ongoing. In addition, \$55 million has been programmed for projects that are in development, where funding has not yet been allocated. Furthermore, \$1.7 million has been identified in savings, which is available for

future allocation. The remaining two percent, totaling \$8 million, is reserved for administrative costs.

Appendix C identifies all open Intercity Rail Improvement, Proposition 1B Bond projects and displays the bond amount programmed, bond funding allocated, funding phase, and percentage of completion for the open projects. This list also contains completed projects, Intercity Rail Improvement Proposition 1B expenditures, and the date of the Final Delivery Report.

The following PTMISEA projects exemplify the range of intercity rail projects funded by the program:

- **Procurement of Railcars–Capitol Corridor, Pacific Surfliner, San Joaquin:**Provides the State with new equipment for improved reliability and service and ridership expansion, including providing the State with 49 new railcars.
- Van Nuys North Platform–Pacific Surfliner, Metrolink: Van Nuys North Platform expands passenger loading to a second rail track. The platform will enhance Americans with Disabilities Act access and safety and efficiency of passenger loading and provide station access for trains from the two mainline tracks.
- Wayside Power and Storage–Capitol Corridor: This project will install wayside power at the Auburn station and layover site, which allows shutdown of the locomotive engines during overnight layover, saving fuel and reducing emissions.
- Sea Cliff Siding Extension Construction—Pacific Surfliner: Extends the existing siding to allow freight trains to wait for passenger trains to pass on the Union Pacific Railroad Santa Barbara Subdivision in Ventura County. This project improves operational reliability, increases capacity, and decreases train delays.
- Wireless Network for Northern California Intercity Passenger Rail Fleet:
 Installation of hardware, wiring, and equipment components necessary to Wi-Fi-enable the equipment fleet for the benefit of the customer's travel experience.
- Santa Margarita Bridge and Double Track: Constructed a double track bridge in northern San Diego County replacing a 100-year-old structure, improving safety and system reliability to the Los Angeles—San Diego— San Luis Obispo Rail corridor.

Conclusion

The PTMISEA program has allocated approximately \$3.945 billion to more than 1,300 projects. The remaining \$55 million in the PTMISEA program is committed to the construction phase of programmed projects and will be allocated in the future. The final distribution of PTMISEA local transit funds was issued by the State Controller's Office in April 2019. However, in accordance with the Budget Act of 2018, these funds are available for encumbrance and liquidation through June 30, 2023; potentially more than 1,500 transit projects can be approved over the timespan PTMISEA funds are viable.

In addition, because many of the projects allocated are multi-year projects, Caltrans anticipates continuing to closely monitor these projects until all are completed as approved and recording benefits and outcomes to ensure compliance. This includes administration and monitoring of new projects expected to be created by amendments, corrective plans, and transference of the PTMISEA funds from existing projects that have identified cost savings, ensuring that funds are expended in accordance with legislation, regulations, and requirements.

CHAPTER 4. STATE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS
ARTICLE 1. GENERAL

16724.4. Any state bond measure approved by the voters on or after January 1, 2004, shall be subject to an annual reporting process, as follows:

- (a) The head of the lead state agency administering the bond proceeds shall report to the Legislature and the Department of Finance no later than January 1, 2005, or the January 1 of the second year following the enactment of the bond measure, whichever is later, and at least once a year thereafter. The annual report shall contain all the following:
 - (1) A list of all projects and their geographical location that have been funded or are required or authorized to receive funds.
 - (2) The amount of funds allocated on each project.
 - (3) The status of any project required or authorized to be funded.
- (b) Costs of the report may be included in the cost of administering the bond measure unless the measure specifically prohibits those expenses.
