2. New PMPC Process Review (PMPC Single Focal Point)

Marcella discusses the change from RPC to PMPC

- Rock Product Committee (RPC) changing to Pavement and Materials Partnering Committee (PMPC)
- Pairing structure down to make it more simple. Instead of 4 Task Groups, there are only 2, Asphalt and Concrete.
- The schedule of the meetings shall follow as stated in Standard Operating Procedures (SOP).
- Caltrans Chairperson is Jackie Wong. Industry lead is Nathan Forrest.
- Idea is to have closed meetings where chairperson/lead has been communicating with stakeholders to bring back comments and concerns.
- Goal is to eliminate project end dates from being dragged out. There should be tight and concise deliverables.
- Limit working group to 4 people from CT and 4 people from industry.
- The PMPC website link is on the RPC webpage. You can find the SOP, meeting calendar, meeting minutes, etc. on the PMPC website.
- If time permits, bring in another Bin List item. You don't need to wait for quarterly meeting. Develop scoping documents covering first 3 points (statement, purpose, background). This is described in the SOP.

General Questions/Discussion

- Jackie- Will PMPC have a search/tracking system? Old RPC website did not have a good system to search for items.
- Potentially include specification writer into working group if specifications are changed. Or, at a minimum, they should be included in the first meeting. Follow SOP.
- 'Unique Concrete Mix Design Naming System' is predominantly a Caltrans process.

Action Items

- Review and prioritize Bin List. Document it and send to Marcella to post on the web.
- Send Marcella meeting minutes to be posted on webpage. Minutes should be finalized and posted within 2 weeks.

3. Review Work Products for this Year, Identify Teams/Resources

General Discussion

- There are scoping document drafts. Working group can take and use as a baseline to expand on.
- Target is to have them completed by next week to give to TG.
- Is a District Rep required for each working group? This may have to change. Use as appropriate.
- District Rep is not needed on Structures related items, more so on Asphalt.

• If District Rep is not on a team, include them on review process. This way all districts are aware of what's ongoing.

Use of 4x8 Cylinders

- Jackie would like someone from OSC. If not then from METS.
- Names are tentative, but should be finalized soon.

Unique Concrete Mix Design

- Nathan will reach out for the remaining members on 'Unique Concrete Mix Design Naming System'
- Industry will not be heavily involved with 'Unique Naming System'. They will be notified on what CT is doing.
- What constitutes a mix design change? Something to look into.
- Most mixes are structurally related, but Pavement can get involved with working group if METS reps are using the mix design tool.

Recycled Crushed Concrete Aggregate

- Project on I-8 in D11 that allowed 15%-20% of recycled aggregate back into concrete mix. Ultimately, contractor did not choose to use the recycled rock in their mix.
- FHWA sponsored project in LA. 2 layers of concrete. One on top of another. Bottom layer contained RCA. Top layer did not.
- The reason for using RCA environmental sense, out of necessity, cost-benefit advantage
- All concrete should be considered for RCA not just pavement. Better to figure out solution and implement before legislation gets involved and make mandatory requirements.
- Pavement could do this as a task order. Working group would then just monitor. If this is a research project, it can get bumped up to management.
- There is concern about limiting group to 4 members. What if one person is missing from meeting due to work load and scheduling. Each working group sets their own meeting schedules. Meetings can be conducted over the phone
