- 1. Introductions/New Members/Review Agenda
 - a. Hadi Nabizadeh is Doug Mason's replacement.
 - b. Kelly being out Sajia Sakhi and Mehrnaz Emami will help track with signing of documents
 - c. Allen King Acting Office Chief for Concrete Pavements
 - d. This is Christa's last meeting. Sudhakar Vatti will be the Bridge Design Chief.
- 2. Action Items from PMPC EC + CTG meeting held on 12/15/2022:
 - a. Action Items Already Completed
- 3. Urgent Issues (All):
 - a. Working on improving document tracking
 - i. Keith: Kelly is out on Sick Leave and that has impacted METS on the consistency of tracking documents.
 - b. Industry no urgent issues.
- 4. CTG Work Products
 - a. Tracking Concrete Mix Designs in DIME (Keith)
 - i. All milestones are complete. Revised SD is being addressed. STG is reviewing the changes. Once updated TG will be moving forwarding the document to EC.
 - ii. Rollout through the districts: incrementally getting the districts up to date on DIME. 5 different tests for Concrete and Asphalt. At this point, districts are not using it.
 - iii. Effort to create a database of all these mixes for future projects. This will help with tracking mixes for EPDs.
 - iv. Keith: Mixed Designs on DIME-all milestones proposed are complete. Final Report from subtask group has been addressed and subtask group is reviewing the changes. Working on Final Report and Scoping Document. Incrementally getting all districts up to date on DIME. We did have a pilot many years back where we did QA and QC for Concrete, which is now a requirement. This new process will be more detailed.
 - v. Tim: we have 5 different tests for concrete, 5 different tests for asphalt. JMF can test mixed designs. Challenge has been coming up with that unique number that we tracked that can be approved. The goal is to come up with a database of these mixes to be used in the future.
 - vi. Revised Scoping Document has been posted.
 - b. Performance Based Alkali–Silica Reaction (ASR) Mitigation (Mark)
 - i. Impasse resolved and rewrite SD. EC signed SD and is posted onto the website.
 - 1. Tom would like to have verification testing and provision on more testing and SCM.
 - a. METS availability to do testing QA is discretionary of the state materials engineer – depending on the location and source will do verification testing. There is only 1 lab that can do the testing.

- b. Mark- we do verification testing on this. Request that we're going to need to have to work this through and that it's not finalized with lane in terms of how that would occur. But my request is that we do verification testing. Even to the point where if we do have aggregates, that we go through this process and if we discover/need more supplementary cementitious material that would also be part of the process.
- c. Keith: depending on location and source we likely will do verification testing
- d. Limited to how many tests we can do in that concrete lab
- e. To get on innocuous list we are using AASHTO credited labs
- c. Blended Supplementary Cementitious Materials (SCMs)
 - CTG Will review and discuss. Action Item: CTG schedule a dedicated SCM 30-minute meeting with EC. Hear from SCM industry, receiving a briefing from Task Group. Implementation.
- d. HIATUS: Replacing the R-Value Testing for Unbound Materials with an Alternate Test Method (Allen)
 - i. Resource issue equipment needs UCPRC helping with testing. \$35K for equipment, UCPRC supposed to be coming up with test method, METS was asked to purchase the equipment. Does UCPRC have the equipment available so testing can be done by Oct 2023?
 - ii. **Action Item:** Allen and Keith Task Group will need to have a meeting to discuss how the testing will be done and will METS need to have equipment implementation test method, then provide EC with an update.
 - iii. Need to revisit the October deadline, particularly if testing equipment is not readily available.
 - 1. Allen The process of signing the new contract with UCPRC may also delay this effort.
 - iv. Raghu and Deepak can provide update on the impacts on HDM and CalME.
 - v. Is R value specified in the construction manual? Moved away from the R value in construction and mostly used in design
