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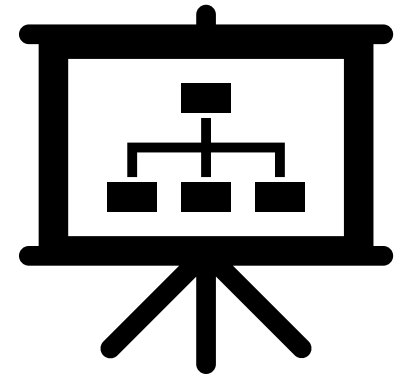
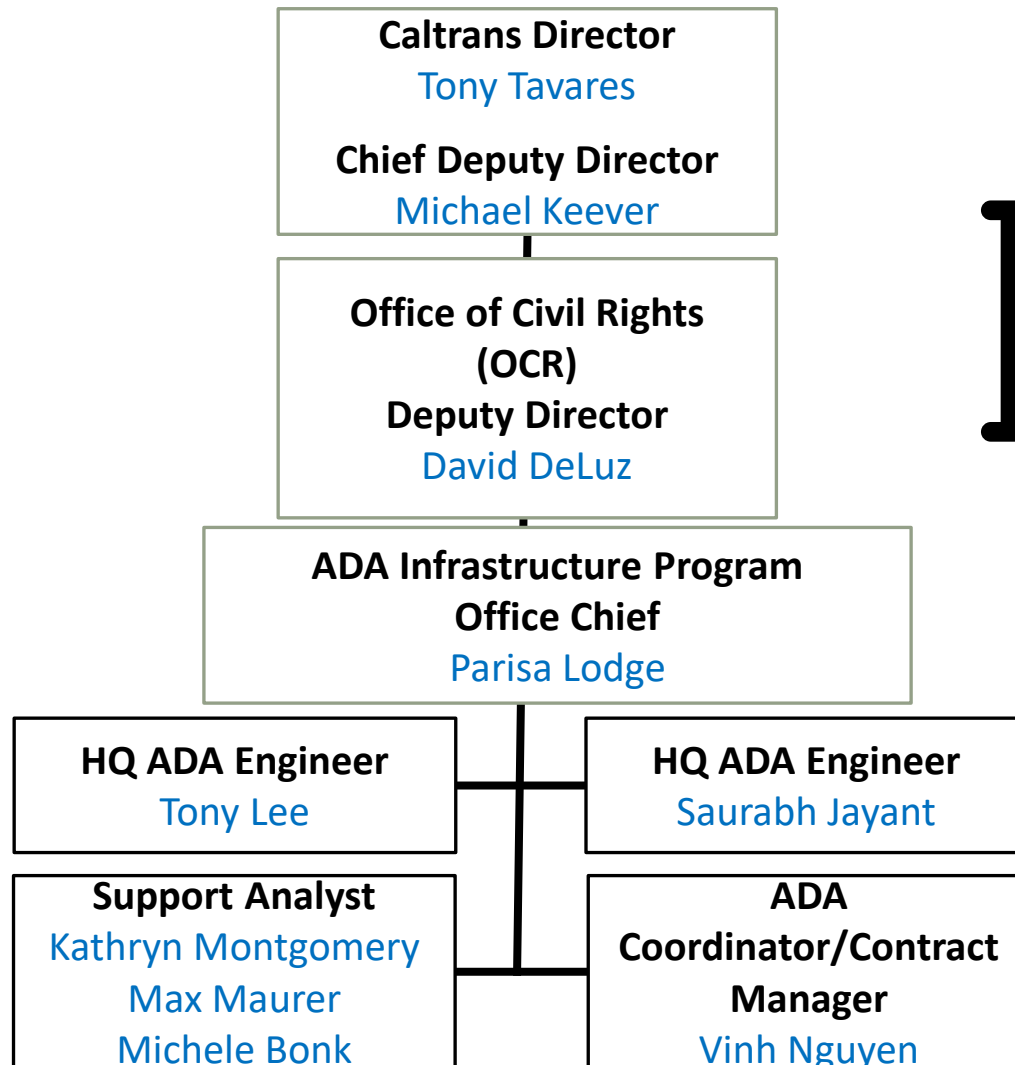

Main Purpose of Work

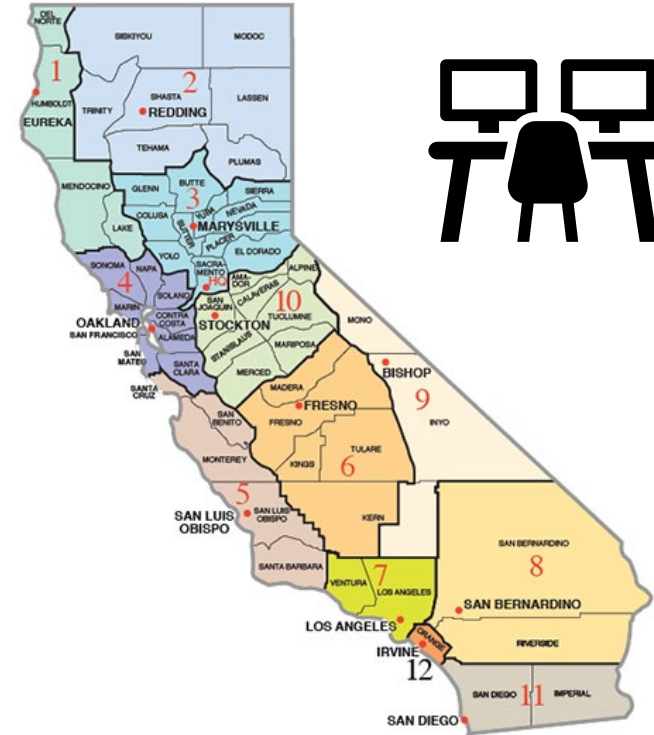
- ❖ Coordination between functional areas related to accessibility matters

- ❖ Ensuring compliance with the terms and conditions in the 2010 Settlement Agreement.



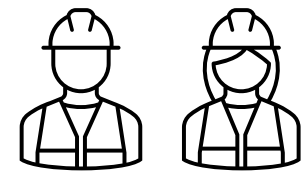
Location of Work

- ❖ In Sacramento and at district field office locations throughout the State of California
- ❖ Consultant will work with District ADA Engineer, Resident Engineer and field inspection personnel and provide ADA compliance data to Caltrans
 - ❖ Example of typical ADA projects:

Dist	County	Route	Post Mile	Location/Description
3	El Dorado	49	14.89-15	Upgrade curb ramps, sidewalk and adjust turn lane to install crosswalk
5	Monterey	Various	Various	ADA curb ramps and minor sidewalk repair
6	Kern	178	4.4	Replace pedestrian overcrossing
9	Inyo	168	16.8-17.5	Construct sidewalks
12	Orange	5	29.6	Upgrade pedestrian facilities within Caltrans right-of-way to current ADA standards



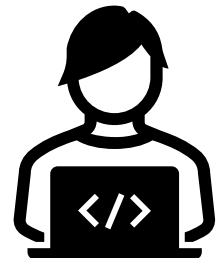
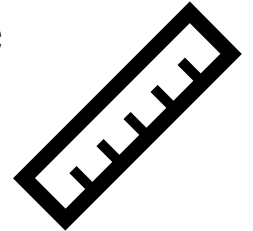
Personnel and Performance



Title	Requirements
Consultant Contract Manager	Minimum 5 years of responsible experience as a contract manager in the field of Civil Engineering. Shall be a licensed PE in the State of California.
Consultant Task Order Manager	Minimum 5 years of construction management or engineering experience on highway projects in California. Shall be a licensed PE in the State of California.
Consultant Task Order Lead	Minimum 5 years of experience in the field of Civil Engineering. Shall be a licensed PE in the State of California.
Engineering Staff	Minimum 2 years of engineering experience on highway projects in California. Shall be a licensed PE in the State of California.
Technical Staff	1 year performing duties comparable to those of a Junior Engineering Technician, Range B in California -OR- 2 years of education beyond the 12th grade in engineering or surveying that includes trigonometry and algebra or higher, drafting, computer science, physics, chemistry, surveying, or a comparable physical science. -OR- 3 years of nonprofessional civil engineering experience and education equivalent to completion of the 12th grade.

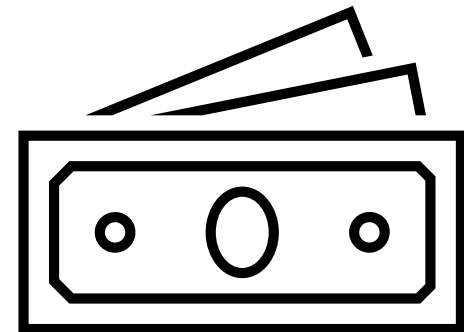
Personnel and Performance

- Consultant personnel should be knowledgeable in the following:
 - Current Caltrans Design Information Bulletin (DIB) 82
 - 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design
 - 2016 California Building Code (Title 24) of the California Code of Regulations
 - Caltrans *Highway Design Manual*
 - California and Federal Access Laws including:
 - *Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG)*
 - *Public Rights-of-Way Accessibility Guidelines (PROWAG)*
 - Title 28 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the Americans with Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C. section 12101, et seq.)
 - Caltrans Standard Plans, as applicable by project
 - Caltrans Standard Specifications, as applicable by project
 - *California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (CA MUTCD)*

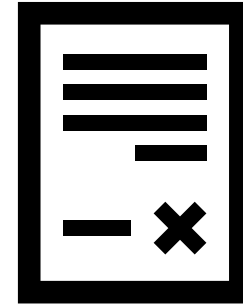


Contract Amount and Term

- ❖ \$2,500,000 +/- 10%
- ❖ Three Years
- ❖ 5% Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise (DVBE)
- ❖ Approximately 30 % field work/oversight
 - ❖ ADA QA role with RE and field staff on active construction jobs
 - ❖ Inspection of ADA facilities on completed projects
