
1. Worker Fatalities in Work Zones






2. Bridges Condition Summary (Good/Fair/Poor)*



3. Percentage of Contract and Procurement Dollars Awarded to Small Businesses









5. Percentage of Encroachment Permits

6. Number of Lane Miles of State Highway System Relinquished (Cumulative)










2. Percentage of Availability of Traveler Information




3. Percentage of Projects That Include Complete Streets Features




4. Average All-Stations On-Time Performance for Intercity Rail









