Full NB I-5 Closure Planned Tomorrow Night; Traffic Shift to Temporary Lanes

NORWALK – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close all northbound lanes of Interstate 5 (I-5) between Norwalk Boulevard and Florence Avenue from 11:59 p.m., Tuesday, January 31 until 5 a.m., Wednesday, February 1, as crews shift traffic to temporary lanes to facilitate the freeway construction. In addition, the northbound I-5 on-ramps at Norwalk Boulevard, Imperial Highway and Pioneer Boulevard will be closed during this time.

DETOUR ROUTE: Motorists will be directed to exit northbound I-5 at Norwalk Boulevard, continue straight through the intersection onto Adoree Street, turn left on Imperial Highway, and turn right on Hoxie Ave. to access the northbound Interstate 605 (I-605) freeway on-ramp to transition back to I-605.

The Santa Ana Freeway (Interstate 5) High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV), Imperial Highway/ Pioneer Boulevard Project extends from Silverbow Avenue to Orr and Day Road in the city of Norwalk. The project will widen nearly two miles of I-5 and will add one carpool lane, and one general purpose lane in each direction. Go to my51a.com and [QuickMap](#) for more information.
