I-405 Ramp Closures in San Fernando Valley Scheduled for Pavement Work and Sound Wall Project

Project to Enhance Safety

LOS ANGELES — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will temporarily close the Victory Boulevard off ramp of the southbound San Diego Freeway (I-405) in Van Nuys to do pavement work, realign part of a sound wall and install a concrete barrier.

The following schedule will be in effect, weather permitting, and is subject to change:

Monday, May 9, through Friday, May 13

Southbound I-405 only:

- 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Victory Boulevard off ramp closed.
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Victory Boulevard off ramp closed.

The #4 Lane (slow lane) of southbound I-405 approaching the Victory Boulevard off ramp also is scheduled to be closed each night from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. to allow for the work.

Highland Construction, Inc. of Orange is the contractor on this project, which is designed to enhance safety by realigning a portion of the sound wall near the off ramp. The project also includes installation of a concrete barrier in place of a guard rail, upgrading the lighting system and widening the ramp terminus of the off ramp.

The ramp and lane closures are expected to end by September if not sooner.
