Rock Removal Operations Planned Along State Route 27 Tomorrow

Topanga Canyon – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will conduct rock removal operations along State Route 27, at Post Mile 3.2, approximately one mile south of Old Topanga Canyon Road in Topanga Canyon, to clear rocks dislodged as a result of the recent storms.

The rock removal is scheduled for Wednesday, January 18, at 9 a.m. and is anticipated to last several hours. Crews will begin conducting one-way traffic control with flaggers to allow motorists to safely pass while the rocks are removed from the hillside.

Motorists will be informed via signs posted at various locations along SR-27.
