



WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to install a concrete median barrier along 4.65 miles of Route 101 south of Arroyo Grande in San Luis Obispo County from Los Berros Undercrossing to Traffic Way in Arroyo Grande. This project proposes to install median barrier to decrease the potential for cross median and run-off-the-road collisions towards the median.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

The public notice serves as an announcement that Caltrans will hold a meeting to:

- Discuss the project purpose and need on Highway 101 within the project limits.
- Provide a forum where you can hear more information about the project and express concerns to Caltrans staff about the project and its relationship to your local community.
- Provide the public an opportunity to meet the project team.

Staff will be available to answer specific questions about the project.
