## **NORTHBOUND U.S. HIGHWAY 101 MAINTENANCE IN PRUNEDALE NEXT WEEK**

MONTEREY COUNTY –A one-mile, week-long maintenance project on **northbound** Highway 101 between Messick Road and Mallory Canyon in Prunedale will begin next Monday, Sept. 28, Caltrans officials have announced.

Roadwork consists of various maintenance work including grinding and paving, tree and landscape work, as well as electrical work which requires the closure of the #2 (right) lane. Work hours are 9 am to 3 pm each day.

NOTE: There will be Electronic Message Boards alerting motorists, who can expect a delay not to exceed 15 minutes. The CHP will be assisting with traffic control.

The purpose of this project is to provide motorists and cyclists a safer route to travel. This project is expected to complete by Friday, Oct. 2.

This work is being performed by Santa Cruz Maintenance, Landscape, Tree and Electrical crews.
