HWY. 183 BIENNIAL GROUNDWATER MONITORING IN SALINAS—NEXT WEEK

SALINAS – Crews will perform a one-day biennial (twice a year) groundwater monitoring project on southbound #2 (slow) lane of Highway 183 between the Villa Street and New Street Intersections, across from 308 West Market Street in Salinas next Wednesday, March 19, Caltrans officials have announced.

The #2 (slow, right) lane of southbound Hwy. 183 will be closed from 9 am to 2 pm. Up to 10 minute delays can be anticipated.

The contractor for this permit project is Stantec Consulting of San Luis Obispo.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through construction zones.
