## **PAVEMENT PRESERVATION PROJECT ALONG HIGHWAY 1 BETWEEN AGUAJITO ROAD IN MONTEREY AND DEL MONTE BOULEVARD IN MARINA**

MONTEREY COUNTY – A 7-½ mile pavement preservation project is underway along Highway 1 between Aguajito on-ramp in Monterey to the Del Monte off-ramp in Marina, Caltrans officials announced today.

Roadwork will be done primarily at night, but daytime work will also take place. Details are as follows:

### Nights on Hwy. 1 Mainline:

- Northbound: Mon-Thurs 8 pm to 7 am, Friday midnight to 7 am and 8 pm to midnight on Sunday.
- Southbound: Mon-Thurs 7 pm to 6 am, Friday midnight to 6 am and 8 pm to midnight on Sunday.

### Connector closures westbound and southbound near Fremont St./Hwy. 68:

- Mon-Thurs 7 pm to 6 am, midnight to 6 am on Friday and 7 pm to midnight on Sunday.

### Ramps

- Daytime and overnight work.

**NOTE: There will be electronic message boards alerting motorists of closures. Motorists can expect delays up to 20 minutes.**

The purpose of this project is to grind and pave traveled lanes, shoulders and ramps, as well as making signal and lighting improvements.

The contractor for this \$7.1 million construction project is Granite Construction Company from Watsonville, CA. Roadwork is expected to be completed this spring.

**Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.**
