CONSTRUCTION PROJECT IN PACIFIC GROVE AT THE INTERSECTION OF HIGHWAY 68 WEST (FOREST) AND DAVID AVENUES—BEGINS MONDAY

PACIFIC GROVE – Crews will begin a construction project to replace a masonry retaining wall with a soldier pile wall, remove and replace a signal, reconstruct drainage and replace a fence at the intersection of Hwy. 68 West (Forest) and David Avenues on Monday, September 14, Caltrans officials have announced.

Hwy. 68 westbound (Forest Ave.) traffic, #2 (right) turn lane onto David Ave. will be closed 24/7 with temporary guardrail. The traffic turning right onto David Ave. will be detoured around and placed in the David Ave. to Forest Ave. turn-pocket with accompanying lane shift for David Ave.

Primary work hours are from 8:30 am to 4 pm Monday through Friday. Motorists can expect 15-20 minute delays during the morning and afternoon weekday commutes (7 am to 8:30 am and 2:30 pm to 5:30 pm) and 10-15 minute delays during non-commute hours.

NOTE: David Ave. traffic will only be affected during daytime work hours.

The contractor for this \$350,000 construction project is Gordon N. Ball, Inc. of Alamo, CA. Project is scheduled for completion in November.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
