ONE-DAY CHIP SEAL OPERATION ON HIGHWAY 183 BETWEEN SALINAS AND CASTROVILLE—WEDNESDAY, JULY 1

MONTEREY COUNTY –A one-day chip seal project along a two-mile section Hwy. 183 from north of San Jon Rd. to south of Espinosa Slough Bridge, between Salinas and Castroville will take place on Wednesday, July 1, Caltrans officials announced today. Details are as follows:

- Both directions of Hwy. 183 from north of San Jon Rd. to south of Espinosa Slough Bridge
- Wednesday, July 1 from 6 am to 6 pm
- Traffic control consists of one-way reversing traffic control with flagging
- Up to 15 minute delays are anticipated.

NOTE: There will be electronic message signs alerting motorists and the CHP will be present to assist with the detour and traffic control.

Traffic control is being performed by the Caltrans Salinas Maintenance crew as a safety precaution to provide motorists and bicyclists a safer route to travel.

The contractor for this \$87,000 maintenance project is Main Street Materials of San Juan Capistrano, CA.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
