U.S. HIGHWAY 101 RESURFACING PROJECT IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY CONTINUES NEXT WEEK WITH RAMP CLOSURES AT PATTERSON AVENUE

SANTA BARBARA COUNTY – A project to resurface US Highway 101 in both directions from north of Cathedral Oaks Road to north of Turnpike Road will continue next week with the closure of the US Highway 101 **northbound on-ramp and southbound off-ramp** at Patterson Avenue beginning Tuesday, Dec. 8 through Thursday, Dec. 10 from 8 am until 4 pm for paving.

Motorists will be able to use the on/off ramps at Los Carneros Road or Turnpike Road. Electronic message boards will assist motorists driving in this area.

The contractor for this \$9.4 million project is Granite Construction of Santa Barbara, CA. This project is expected to be completed in February of 2016, weather permitting.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
