ONE DAY RAMP CLOSURE ON HIGHWAY 154 NEAR BUELLTON—TUESDAY NOV. 12

SANTA BARBARA COUNTY – A one day maintenance project to grind and pave the southbound Hwy. 101 off-ramp (at Hwy. 154 near Buellton) will take place on Tuesday, November 12.

Roadwork hours are from 8 am to 3 pm. Motorists will experience a delay not to exceed 10 minutes.

This is the southbound off-ramp from Hwy. 101 onto Hwy. 154 heading towards Santa Barbara. Motorists can continue south on Hwy. 101 for approximately ½ mile and use a turn-pocket to return to the northbound Hwy. 101 off-ramp at Hwy. 154.

Electronic message signs will be in place to alert motorists of this ramp closure. The CHP will be present to assist with traffic control.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
