

Right of Way Process


Deeds and Maps to Right of Way – Appraisal Maps are a visual tool that show land and improvements, while Deeds provide a legal description of the areas to be acquired for the project.

Appraisal – Appraisals are necessary to ensure compliance with the Constitution in arriving at a conclusion of just compensation.

Acquisitions – The Acquisition Branch is responsible for the timely securing of property rights necessary for the project while adhering to the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act.

Utility Relocations – The Utilities Branch is responsible for the relocation and removal of utility facilities that are either in physical conflict or in violation of the Department's utility policy.

Relocation Assistance – The Relocation Assistance Program ensures that persons displaced as a result of a state highway project are treated fairly, consistently, and equitably so that persons will not suffer disproportionate injuries as a result of projects designed for the benefit of the public as a whole.
