## **TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM ARCH ROAD TO THE SAN JOAQUIN/SACRAMENTO COUNTY LINE**

**San Joaquin County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Arch Road to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on both northbound and southbound SR-99 from Arch Road to SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will alternately close beginning Sunday, April 10, 2016, through Friday, April 15, 2016, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps, and the overcrossing at Mariposa Road are closed and scheduled to reopen summer 2016;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps from SR-99 to Golden Gate Avenue will close beginning Sunday, April 10, 2016, through Friday, April 15, 2016, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on SR-99 from Hammer Lane to the South Lodi Overcrossing will alternately close beginning Sunday, April 10, 2016, through Friday, April 15, 2016, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound SR-99 from the Hammer Lane to South Lodi Overcrossing will alternately close beginning Sunday, April 10, 2016, through Friday, April 15, 2016, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes on northbound and southbound SR-99 from the South Lodi Overcrossing to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line will alternately close beginning Sunday, April 10, 2016, through Friday, April 15, 2016, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;

- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on SR-99 from South Lodi Overcrossing to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line will alternately close beginning Sunday, April 10, 2016, through Friday, April 15, 2016, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and construction related issues.
