

MAJOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS 2010 SAN DIEGO COUNTY

- ① Construct four-lane conventional highway on SR-76
A from Melrose Drive to South Mission Road.
T Cost: \$181 million. Completion: Winter 2012.
- ② Install ramp meters on I-5 from Birmingham Drive to just south of Vandegrift Boulevard/Harbor Drive.
 Cost \$ 6.5 million. Completion: Fall 2010.
- ③ Construct I-15 Express Lanes (North Segment) from Centre City Parkway to SR-78.
T Cost: \$215 million. Completion: Fall 2011.
- ④ Construct I-15 Express Lanes (South Segment) from SR-163 to SR-56.
B Cost: \$412 million. Completion: Fall 2012.
- ⑤ Construct HOV lane and northbound Direct Access Ramp on I-805 from Carroll Canyon Road to the I-5/I-805 Merge. Also extend Carroll Canyon Road from Scranton Way to Sorrento Valley Boulevard.
T A Cost: \$69.7 million. Completion: 2012.
- ⑥ City of San Diego project to convert the cloverleaf interchange at La Jolla Village Drive on I-805 to a partial-cloverleaf.
 Cost \$19 million. Completion: Fall 2012.
- ⑦ Construct new freeway SR-52 from SR-125 to Cuyamaca Street (Unit 4).
B Cost: \$76.3 million. Completion: 2010.
- ⑧ Construct middle segment of new freeway SR-52 from Cuyamaca Street to Magnolia Avenue (Unit 5B).
T Cost: \$40 million. Completion: 2010.
- ⑨ Construct new freeway SR-52 at SR-67 (Unit 5A).
T B Cost: \$88.5 million. Completion: 2010.
- ⑩ Repave I-8 from Willows Road to Japatul Valley Road.
 Cost \$5.5 million. Completion Summer 2010.
- ⑪ Widen eastbound I-8 to three lanes between the 2nd Street on-ramp and the Greenfield Drive off-ramp.
 Cost: \$15.5 million. Completion: Late 2012.
- ⑫ Repave I-805 from Murray Ridge Road to SR-163.
 Cost \$2 million. Completion Summer 2010.
- ⑬ Modify signals, signing, and striping at the intersection of the I-8 ramp at West Mission Bay Dr/Midway Dr. Improvements will also be made to the median and the pedestrian ramps.
 Cost \$978,000. Completion: Winter 2010.
- ⑭ Widen and modify the off-ramp on westbound SR-94 at College Avenue.
 Cost: \$2.4 million. Completion: Summer 2010.
- ⑮ Construct southbound I-805 auxiliary lane from SR-54 to Bonita Road.
A Cost: \$14 million. Completion: Summer 2010.
- ⑯ Upgrade sidewalk to current American with Disabilities Act standards on SR-75 from Saturn Boulevard to 9th Street.
 Cost: \$424,000. Completion: Fall 2010.
- ⑰ Construct new six-lane freeway SR-905 from Britannia Boulevard to just east of the I-805/SR-905 interchange.
T B A Cost \$85 million. Completion: Summer 2012.
- ⑱ Construct new six-lane freeway SR-905 from Siempre Viva Road interchange to Britannia Boulevard.
B Cost: \$77 million. Completion: Fall 2010.
- ⑲ U.S. General Services Administration project to modify the San Ysidro Port of Entry on I-5.
 Cost: \$577 million. Completion: Summer 2015.
