## STATE ROUTE 241 – FULL FREEWAY CLOSURE SCHEDULED

**Irvine**—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will commence a bridge maintenance project along Interstate 5 & State Route 241 in various locations with the first order of work consisting of a full freeway closure on the Northbound SR-241 from Los Alisos Boulevard to Portola Parkway, the week of September 24, 2012 in the City of Mission Viejo.

### Recommended Detour:

- Northbound SR-241 motorists will exit at Los Alisos, turn left on Los Alisos, make a right on Santa Margarita Parkway, Santa Margarita changes to Portola Parkway, proceed on Portola Parkway to the SR-241

The scope of work includes cleaning and replacing joint seals, replacing joint seal assemblies, repairing deck and joint spalls by removing unsound concrete and patching with rapid setting concrete patches, cleaning bridge and treating decks, modifying abutments and resetting bearing pads. Detours will be posted.

Once complete, motorists will benefit from a smoother ride.
