

## **SR-91 Westbound Lane Widening Project - SR-57 to I-5 Week of September 16, 2013**

Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) in partnership with the Department of Transportation (Caltrans), will be adding a new, four-mile westbound general-purpose lane to State Route 91 between State Route 57 and Interstate 5.

As part of the SR-91 Westbound Lane Widening Project, construction crews will demolish the edge of the overpass at Acacia Street tonight, Monday, September 16 and close Acacia Street in both the North and Southbound directions Monday, September 16th and Tuesday, September 17th.

Motorists will be detoured around the construction area via Romneya, State College, Raymond /East Street and Orangethorpe. Parking under the freeway and north of the freeway overcrossing is prohibited. Detour signage will be posted for all ramp and surface street closures. Adjacent ramps servicing two consecutive local streets will not be closed simultaneously.

### **Monday, September 16<sup>th</sup>**

Full Closure – Surface Street - Acacia Street, North and Southbound 3:30 p.m. to 12 a.m.

Alternate Lane Closures SR-91, State College Blvd to East Street 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

### **Tuesday, September 17<sup>th</sup>**

Full Closure – Surface Street - Acacia Street, North and Southbound 3:30 p.m. to 12 a.m.
