


SR-17 Capital Maintenance Paving Project



Construction Activities:

Monday through Friday at night; however, some weekend night work is possible. Weekday work on the highway will start at 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following day; however, ramps and connectors could be closed both day and night.

The Caltrans Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a maintenance project to rehabilitate and preserve the existing roadway on State Route 17 (SR-17) in Santa Clara County between State Route 9 and just south of State Route 85. The project is expected to start towards the end of June, 2011.

The project will replace failed concrete and asphalt sections and place an overlay of asphalt pavement on the highway and the on / off ramps at the junction of State Route 9 and at Lark Ave. In addition, maintenance will replace ramp loop detectors as well as install new metal beam guardrails throughout the project area.

Construction will be Monday through Friday at night; however, some weekend night work is possible. There will be partial freeway closures on SR-17 with at least one lane always open. Weekday work on the highway will start each night at 10:00 p.m. All weekday construction work on the highway will end on or before 5:00 a.m. The project is expected to be completed in Fall, 2011. There may be full ramp or connector closures during this project.
