TRAFFIC CONTROL RESUMES OCTOBER 17-21 ON STATE ROUTE 168 NEAR SHAVER LAKE

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that traffic will resume next week on State Route 168 north of Shaver Lake as part of an ongoing tree removal project.

The following one-way traffic control will be in effect, weather permitting:

- One-way traffic control will be in effect on State Route 168 north of Shaver Lake beginning Monday, October 17 through Friday, October 21 from 7:00 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. each day. Traffic delays are expected to last up to 15-minutes.

Tree removal operations south of Shaver Lake finished this week and there will not be any more traffic control in this area.

Closures may continue for longer periods of time each day if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during tree removal operations. These scheduled closures will occur, weather permitting.

Commuters are reminded to obey flagging personnel and pay close attention to maintenance vehicles and personnel at all times.
