CALTRANS ANNOUNCES UPCOMING DELAYS ON STATE ROUTE 168 NEAR SHAVER LAKE NEXT WEEK

WHAT: RETAINING WALL INSTALLATION AND CULVERT REPAIR PROJECT NEAR SHAVER LAKE IN FRESNO COUNTY.

FLAGGERS WILL BE CONDUCTING REVERSING LANE AND CONTINUOUS TRAFFIC CONTROL OPERATIONS IN ORDER TO REPLACE CULVERTS ACROSS THE ROADWAY. TRAFFIC IN EACH DIRECTION WILL BE HALTED FOR APPROXIMATELY 20-MINUTE INTERVALS IN ORDER TO SAFELY IMPLEMENT THIS PROJECT.

WHEN: BEGINNING NEXT WEEK, TUESDAY, JUNE 1ST-FRIDAY, JUNE 4TH FROM 7:00 A.M. UNTIL 6:00 P.M. **MOTORISTS SHOULD EXPECT UP TO A 20-MINUTE DELAY WITHIN THE PROJECT LIMITS. (WEATHER PERMITTING)**

WHERE: WITHIN FRESNO COUNTY; NEAR SHAVER LAKE, 16.6 MILES SOUTH OF THE END OF STATE ROUTE 168 TO 9.2 MILES SOUTH OF TAMARACK CREEK.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces on-going construction for an improvement project on State Route 168 near the Shaver Lake Boat Harbor Marina will improve rock wall stabilization efforts and drainage improvements near this area.

The public will experience longer than usual delays within the project area next week in order to implement culvert installation and drainage operations at this location.

AGEE Construction is the contractor and it is anticipated this project will be completed in July 2010. (Weather and contractor schedule permitting)

Caltrans would like to thank the residents, businesses and commuters for their patience during this improvement project. The public is reminded to drive with extra care while traveling through this construction zone, adhere to all construction signage and be alert to all construction personnel and equipment at all times.
