



State Route 14 North Mojave 4-Lane Kern County

Project Purpose:

The purpose of this project is to improve operation and safety, while increasing the level of service for traffic volume at the California City Boulevard and State Route 14 intersection. An elevated roadbed and bridges at Cache Creek wash are needed to eliminate road closures due to previous flooding issues and to improve the drainage for the entire length of this project.

Project Description:

This project is located in Kern County on State Route 14 from north of the Business Route 58 Junction in Mojave to north of California City Boulevard. This project is converting this segment of State Route 14 from a two-lane conventional highway into a four-lane expressway. This project includes construction of a new interchange and elevation of existing roadbeds and bridges in order to eliminate previous flooding issues and improve drainage for the entire length of the project.

Construction Cost: \$50 Million

Begin Construction: February 2006
End Construction: December 2007

Funding Sources: Interregional Transportation Improvement Program (ITIP), Regional Improvement Program (RIP) by Kern County Association of Governments (KCOG), Mono County and Inyo County

Contractor: Granite Construction Co.
