Subject: Contract No. 10-0Y1204 – Bid Protest Response

Dear Mr. McMillan:

Sierra Nevada Construction, Inc. ("SNC") is in receipt of Caltrans' March 27, 2014 letter, which enclosed a bid protest filed by Teichert Construction ("Teichert") on the Project known as Contact No. 10-0Y1204 (the "Project"). This letter serves as SNC's formal response to Teichert's bid protest, and, based on the response below, an affirmation that SNC should be awarded the contract for the Project as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

Essentially, Teichert's bid protest improperly invites Caltrans to look well-beyond the actual bid submitted by SNC, and to make subjective determinations premised on wild speculation and hypothetical circumstances concocted by Teichert concerning two out of twenty-two bid items. Caltrans should decline this invitation, as this type of speculative inquiry is not allowed under California law, and must be rejected. *See MCM Construction, Inc. v. City & County of San Francisco* (1998) 66 Cal.App.4th 359, 368 (whether a bid is responsive can be determined from the face of the bid without outside investigation or information). Here, it is both unnecessary and improper for Caltrans to look beyond the face of the bid documents submitted by SNC, and Teichert's protest must therefore fail as a matter of law.

Teichert's protest potentially opens the door for any aggrieved, disappointed losing bidder to seek to reevaluate bid quantities identified by Caltrans in its own bidding documents for purposes of manufacturing an alternative bid summary list utilizing "revised" quantities advantageous only to the protesting bidder. Such attempts to "re-order" Caltrans' bid summary

list will turn the bid process on its ear by promoting a cumbersome, imprecise analysis of each and every item on a Caltrans bid schedule, and the entire bidding process will be undermined if bidders are unable to rely upon the given quantities for purposes of determining the lowest responsive bid. Where does the inquiry promoted by Teichert stop? This type of over-reaching evaluation will inevitably lead to bid protests dealing with dozens, if not hundreds, of separate issues, and holding-up the award of contracts for weeks or months. Teichert's attempt to create an issue here will establish a bad precedent, and should not be countenanced by Caltrans.

Teichert's tortured analysis of SNC's Bid Item 12 illustrates the very reason why its protest is myopic. Teichert uses non-verified extrinsic evidence and calculations to try to dispel and trivialize a quantity provided by Caltrans in its own bid form. The game of "what if" offered by Teichert in its bid protest could be played for each and every bid item. For example, Teichert's unit costs for Bid Items 10, 11, and 13 are substantially higher than the unit costs bid by SNC (copies of the SNC and Teichert bids are enclosed with this letter). In applying Teichert's own logic, Teichert's bid would *increase* substantially if there is an overrun as to those quantities as identified in the bid documents. Contrary to what Teichert asserts, and in light of the highly speculative nature Teichert's arguments and assumptions, there is significant doubt that Teichert's bid will be the true overall low bid even if Teichert's arguments are assumed.

In fact, Teichert's own argument supports a finding that Caltrans needs to solely focus on the quantities and prices provided on bid day, and which are found in Caltrans' own bidding documents. Simply stated, the bidding process set forth by Caltrans would turn into chaos if Teichert's position is adopted as the standard for evaluating bids on Caltrans projects. The line needs to be drawn – the bidders have to be able to rely upon the quantities identified for bidding purposes by Caltrans, and Caltrans needs to rely on the prices submitted by the bidders. At the heart of Teichert's bid protest is an inherent challenge to those concepts, and giving credence to the positions advocated by Teichert compromises the integrity of the Caltrans bidding process.

Further, California law frowns upon the very type of post-bid analysis and explanations sought by Teichert in its bid protest. A bidder may not correct its bid after bid opening. *See e.g., National Coach Corp. v. Board of Control* (1982) 137 Cal.App.3d 754; *Amendola Construction Co.* (1984) Comp.Gen.Dec. B-214258 (bidder may not change, correct or explain bid "after bid opening since to permit this would give the firm the option of accepting or rejecting a contract after bids are exposed"); and *Parco, a Division of Blue Mountain Products, Inc.* (1983) Comp.Gen. Dec. B-211016 (bid may not be considered for correction after bid opening because competitors' bids had already been revealed). The holdings and policies of the above cases apply to the instant matter in that Teichert is requesting a similar analysis, which is to delve into the particulars of a bid that on its face is fully compliant with all requirements of the bidding

documents. Teichert's bid protest will effectively open "Pandora's box" by establishing a "right" for a protesting bidder to insist that Caltrans perform a subjective post-bid analysis to validate its own bidding document, which will require detailed explanation and/or information not contained within the bidding documents.

SNC strongly contends that the above arguments soundly defeat Teichert's bid protest, and merit an award of the contract to SNC. Out of an abundance of caution, however, SNC addresses Teichert's bid unbalancing arguments, below.

First, we understand that Caltrans follows federal law in evaluating whether bids are unbalanced and thus nonresponsive (see enclosed June 11, 2002 Caltrans Memorandum). Federal law supports SNC's contention that its bid is not unbalanced.

Federal bidding decisions have observed that, "bid pricing involves subjective business judgments and that comparison of a competitor's prices with one's own prices is not by itself sufficient to establish that a bid is unbalanced." *Ultra Technology Corp.*, B-230309.6, Jan. 18, 1989, 89-1 CPD p. 42; *Unidynamics/St. Louis, Inc.*, B-232295, Dec. 21, 1988, 88-2 CPD p. 609. Based on these cases, Teichert's analysis is flawed since it is premised upon the comparison of bid prices.

Moreover, federal statutory and case law holds that before a bid can be rejected as unbalanced, it must be found to be both mathematically and materially unbalanced. *Sanford Cooling*, B-242423, April 15, 1991, 91-1 CPD, p. 376. As the enclosed June 11, 2002 Memorandum states in the second paragraph on page one, "[W]hile a mathematically unbalanced bid is not desirable *it may be acceptable*; however, a mathematically unbalanced bid must be evaluated further to determine if it is also a materially unbalanced bid." (Emphasis added).

The guiding factor for determining whether a mathematically unbalanced bid is also materially unbalanced is the accuracy of the government's estimate of the anticipated quantity of work to be performed--if the estimate is reasonably accurate, then a mathematically unbalanced low bid may be accepted. *Edward B. Friel, Inc. et al.*, 55 Comp.Gen. 488 (1975), 75-2 CPD p. 333. In this matter, Teichert's entire argument focuses on its assumption that Caltrans' anticipated quantity for Bid Item 12 is incorrect (too high) on the face of the bidding documents. Based on federal law, any perceived mathematical unbalancing by SNC for Bid Item 12 is irrelevant since the accuracy of Caltrans' quantity is presumed.

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A bid may be considered mathematically unbalanced if the bid is structured on the basis of nominal prices for some work and inflated prices for other work; that is, each element of the bid must carry its proportionate share of the total cost of the work plus profits. *Matter of: Howell Construction, Comp. Gen. B-225766 (1987)*. As admitted by Teichert, SNC's unit price for Bid Item 12 is not nominal. Interestingly, the letters Teichert attached to its bid protest that contained prior Caltrans' rejections of unbalanced bids focused on bid items that contained nominal unit prices. Based on the above cited federal law, Teichert's protest fails since the crux of its protest is irrelevant under federal law.

SNC also strongly contends that its bid is not materially unbalanced. Pursuant to 23 CFR 635.012, a materially unbalanced bid is defined as "a bid which generates a reasonable doubt that award to the bidder submitting a mathematically unbalanced bid will result in the lowest ultimate cost to the Federal Government." Case law has also affirmed that a bid is materially unbalanced when there is a reasonable doubt that acceptance of a mathematically unbalanced bid--that is, one that contains understated prices for some items and overstated prices for others--will result in the lowest overall cost to the government. *Sharp Constr. Co., Inc., B-244682, July 12, 1991*. In essence, a materially unbalanced bid must serve as an advantage to the contractor and a **potential disadvantage to the owner.**

As detailed above, it is impossible for Caltrans – or Teichert – to determine at this time whether there is any potential disadvantage to Caltrans by accepting SNC's bid. Caltrans' quantity for Bid Item 12 may very well be accurate (and indeed are presumed to be accurate). As such, Teichert's bid will remain higher than SNC's bid if the actual Bid Item 12 quantities are consistent with the quantities as represented in the bidding documents, and Teichert's bid could end up being much higher than SNC's if the actual quantities for Bid Items 10, 11 and 13 are overrun. Again, Teichert's "what if" game can be skewed to yield many different results, and to provide almost any outcome that an aggrieved bidder might want to promote.

SNC acknowledges that the price identified for E.M. Oil Transport as listed in its Certified Small Business Listing is higher than the amount identified in Bid Item 12. SNC provided a lower price in Bid Item 12, which is neither improper nor barred under California law, since the final quantities for Bid Item 12 would need to be verified in the field during performance of the contract and providing the amount identified for E.M. Oil Transport in Bid Item 12 could lead to an unfair underpayment to SNC and the small businesses SNC intends to utilize at the Project.

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Similarly, SNC put more money into the traffic control systems bid item to ensure that SNC would provide a full and complete bid price, to protect SNC from potential discrepancies in bid quantities, and since the traffic control bid item is assured to be performed and paid out over the entirety of the Project. By putting additional amounts in the traffic control bid item, SNC avoided "front loading" its bid price, which is frowned upon by federal standards. Clearly, SNC made subjective business judgments in how it prepared its bid, but these business judgments were based on experience and ultimately provided Caltrans with the lowest bid price. **SNC did not receive any advantage in how it balanced its bid since its total price was fair and consistent with the prices submitted by the other bidders, including Teichert.**

Any perceived mathematical unbalancing by SNC is likely to result in an advantage to Caltrans. SNC has accepted the risks of being incorrect for Bid Item 12 - if the quantities are higher than identified in the bidding documents, SNC will receive a lower compensation than its actual costs due to its assigned unit cost for that item. Further, any mathematical unbalancing associated with the traffic control system bid item will only result in an advantage to Caltrans, since there cannot be a variance in that lump sum cost item.

SNC did not seek to conceal its costs for Bid Item 12 in other quantity based bid items, but instead included those costs in a transparent and obvious fashion by including them in the traffic control system bid item. SNC, and all bidders, should be encouraged to make subjective business judgments concerning how they will bid a project, and that is exactly what SNC has done in this instance by virtue of allocating costs among certain Bid Items. In that regard, Caltrans is receiving the lowest bid price and lowest overall Project cost from SNC, and it is a price that is not dependent on quantity fluctuations.

Finally, even if, *assuming arguendo*, Caltrans is inclined to give some credence to Teichert's unbalancing argument, SNC contends that any perceived infirmity in SNC's bid arising from alleged unbalancing should be waived as a minor irregularity. Any deviation from the bid documents that is a minor irregularity can be waived. *See Ghilotti Const. Co. v. Richmond* (1996) 45 Cal.App.4th 897; *Konica Business Machines v. Regents* (1988) 206 Cal.App.3d 449. The law on the topic of waiving minor irregularities is clear: a public agency may waive the deviation if: 1) the deviation could not have affected the amount of the bid or 2) could not have given the bidder an unfair competitive advantage over other bidders by enabling

the bidder to withdraw its bid without forfeiting its bid bond. *Valley Crest Landscape, Inc. v. City Council of the City of Davis, et. al.*, (1996) 41 Cal.App.4th 1432, 1440-1441.

Bid protests must be evaluated from a practical point of view with an emphasis on the particular facts of the case to determine if the alleged deviation warrants imposition of a drastic penalty. *Ghilotti Const. Co., supra*, at 908. In the instant matter, the perceived unbalancing does not give SNC an unfair advantage since SNC's bid is evaluated as a total final price on bid day, and SNC would not have grounds to withdraw its bid by claiming mistake. As appropriately stated by the court in *Judson Pacific-Murphy Corp. v. Durkee* (1956) 144 Cal.App.2d 377, 383:

It certainly would amount to a disservice to the public if a losing bidder were to be permitted to comb through the bid proposal or license application of the low bidder after the fact, cancel the low bid on minor technicalities, with the hope of securing the acceptance of his, a higher bid. Such construction would be adverse to the best interests of the public and contrary to public policy.

Accordingly, having addressed all of the issues raised in Teichert's bid protest, SNC requests that Caltrans immediately issue a Notice of Award confirming that the contract shall be awarded to SNC. To the extent that Caltrans intends to award the contract to anyone other than SNC, please consider this correspondence as a formal request on behalf of SNC for an immediate hearing prior to the award of the contract to any other bidder.


