
The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a bid from ACCU Construction, Inc. (ACCU) on contract 11-265014 on February 27, 2014. ACCU asserts that an error was made in filling out the bid and that it failed to properly carry over additions due to wrong equations and the equations did not include the profit and overhead. The intended bid amount was \$4,018,242; however on bid day was submitted as \$3,494,124.

On March 5, 2014, ACCU requested a relief of bid due to inadvertent clerical error.

In accordance with ACCU's request, the Department finds that ACCU has met the elements of Public Contract Code Sections 5101 and 5103. Therefore, ACCU is hereby relieved of their bid without forfeiture of its bid bond.


