 R A minimum of one paved traffic lane, not less than 11 feet wide, shall be open for use by public traffic. (Reversing Control).
 No closure allowed.

REMARKS:
 1- Maximum length of one-way control shall be 500 feet.
 2- All ramps are to remain open. If necessary, flaggers will be used to control ramp traffic.
 3- No lane closures are allowed on Interstate 5.
 4- See Lane Closure Restriction for Designated Legal Holidays and the day preceding Designated Legal Holidays in "Maintaining Traffic" of these special provisions for additional closure restrictions.
