Addendum No. 1

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for construction on State highway in PLACER COUNTY AT EMIGRANT GAP FROM 0.4 KM WEST OF PUTTS LAKE UNDERCROSSING TO 0.2 KM EAST OF CARPENTER FLAT UNDERCROSSING.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on February 26, 2008.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Project Plans, the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions, the Proposal and Contract, and the Federal Minimum Wages with Modification Number 9 dated 02/08/2008.

Project Plan Sheets 5, 45, 76, 205, 246 and 247 are revised. Half-sized copies of the revised sheets are attached for substitution for the like-numbered sheets.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.01, "ORDER OF WORK," the following paragraphs are added after the first paragraph:

"Within any planned station length of portland cement concrete paving, the following listed operations shall only be performed when the adjacent portland cement concrete paving can be completed in that same construction season, between October 15 and April 15:

1. Work in the median
2. Drainage work
3. Asphalt concrete paving
4. Shoulder work (except for shoulder work within the station limits of "EB1" 102+35.23 to "A1" 108+40 required for the Putt's Lake UC stage 1, phase 2, work.

Carpenter Flat UC shall be constructed only when portland cement concrete paving can be completed up to the bridge."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.01, "ORDER OF WORK," the third paragraph is revised as follows:

"The Contractor shall give notice 15 days in advance to the Engineer and the Traffic Office of Truck Services at (916) 322-4957, when the horizontal clearances are less than 4.88 m and the vertical clearances are less than 5.5 m."

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In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.23, "MAINTAINING TRAFFIC," the eighth paragraph is revised as follows:

"The Contractor shall set up traffic control, to screen, hold, and then escort the permit loads through the work zone, as directed by the Engineer, when the horizontal clearances are less than 4.88 m. The traffic control shall be set up prior to closing a lane."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.23, "MAINTAINING TRAFFIC," in the ninth paragraph "Westbound, Castle Peak Rest Area in Nev-80 KP 9.3 (PM 5.8)" is revised to "Westbound, Truckee, California, Nev-80 KP 21.8 (PM 13.6)."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.23, "MAINTAINING TRAFFIC," Lane Closure Charts No.1, No.2, No.3 and No.4 are revised as attached.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.24, "CLOSURE REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS," subsection "LATE REOPENING OF CLOSURES," in the second paragraph "\$2,300" is revised to "\$1,260."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.25 "TRAFFIC CONTROL SYSTEM FOR LANE CLOSURE," subsection "STATIONARY LANE CLOSURE" the second paragraph is deleted.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.28 "PORTABLE CHANGEABLE MESSAGE SIGN," the second paragraph is revised as follows:

"A portable changeable message sign shall be placed in advance of the first warning sign for each stationary lane, or shoulder closure."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.28 "PORTABLE CHANGEABLE MESSAGE SIGN," the following paragraphs are added after the second paragraph as follows:

"On eastbound Route 80, at Chain Control Area, in Placer County KP 86.5 one portable changeable message sign shall be placed facing eastbound traffic when construction operations require narrowing lanes open to public traffic to less than 4.88 m wide.

On westbound Route 80, Truckee, California, in Nevada County KP 21.8 one portable changeable message sign shall be placed facing westbound traffic when construction operations require narrowing lanes open to public traffic to less than 4.88 m wide."

In the Proposal and Contract, the Engineer's Estimate Items 73 and 79 are revised as attached.

To Proposal and Contract book holders:

Replace page 6 of the Engineer's Estimate in the Proposal with the attached revised page 6 of the Engineer's Estimate. The revised Engineer's Estimate is to be used in the bid.

Inquiries or questions in regard to this addendum must be communicated as a bidder inquiry and must be made as noted in the NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS section of the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

Indicate receipt of this addendum by filling in the number of this addendum in the space provided on the signature page of the proposal.

Submit bids in the Proposal and Contract book you now possess. Holders who have already mailed their book will be contacted to arrange for the return of their book.

Inform subcontractors and suppliers as necessary.
