In the Special Provisions, Section 2-1.01, "GENERAL," the second paragraph is deleted.

In the Special Provisions, Section 2-1.02, "DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE)," is revised as attached.

In the Special Provisions, Section 3, "AWARD AND EXECUTION OF CONTRACT," the second paragraph is deleted.

2-1.02 DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE)

This project is subject to Part 26, Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations entitled "Participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises in Department of Transportation Financial Assistance Programs." The Regulations in their entirety are incorporated herein by this reference.

Failure to carry out the requirements of this paragraph shall constitute a breach of contract and may result in termination of this contract or other remedy the Department may deem appropriate.
