Addendum No. 1

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for construction on State highway in RIVERSIDE COUNTY IN CORONA AT NORTH ROUTE 15 TO WEST ROUTE 91 CONNECTOR OVERCROSSING AND AT TEMESCAL WASH BRIDGE OVERHEAD.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on August 30, 2007.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

In the Special Provisions, Section 3, "AWARD AND EXECUTION OF CONTRACT," the third paragraph is revised by the following paragraph:

"The award of the contract, if made, will be to the lowest responsible bidder whose proposal complies with all the requirements prescribed and who has met the goals for DVBE participation or has demonstrated, to the satisfaction of the Department, good faith efforts to do so. This period will be subject to extension for such further period as may be agreed upon in writing between the Department and the bidder concerned. The contract will not be awarded until the 2007/2008 fiscal year Budget Act becomes law."

In the Special Provisions, Section 4, "BEGINNING OF WORK, TIME OF COMPLETION AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES," the first paragraph is revised by the following paragraphs:

"The first working day is the forty-fifth day after contract approval.

The 72-hour advance notice specified in Section 8-1.03, "Beginning of Work," of the Standard Specifications is changed to 5 days."

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To Proposal and Contract book holders:

Inquiries or questions in regard to this addendum must be communicated as a bidder inquiry and must be made as noted in the NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS section of the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

Indicate receipt of this addendum by filling in the number of this addendum in the space provided on the signature page of the proposal.

Submit bids in the Proposal and Contract book you now possess. Holders who have already mailed their book will be contacted to arrange for the return of their book.

Inform subcontractors and suppliers as necessary.
