This addendum is being issued to the contract for construction on State highway in SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY NEAR CAJON JUNCTION ON ROUTE 15 FROM 1.8 KM NORTH OF JUNCTION ROUTE 138 TO 0.4 KM SOUTH OF SAN BERNARDINO NATIONAL FOREST NORTH BOUNDRY AND IN SAN BERNARDINO ON ROUTE 215 FROM 1.2 KM NORTH OF ROUTE 10/215 SEPARATION TO 0.1 KM SOUTH OF INLAND CENTER DRIVE OVERCROSSING.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on May 2, 2002. The original bid opening date was previously postponed indefinitely under Addendum No. 1 dated March 29, 2002.

This addendum is being issued to set a new bid opening date as shown herein and revise the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.06, "MAINTAINING TRAFFIC," Ramp Closure Charts No. 5, 6 and 7 are added as attached.
