

MAJOR CORRIDOR ISSUES

The plan considered and addressed the following corridor issues:

- Freight and goods movement
- Future levels of inward commuting to Bay Area
- Access, mobility and safety
- Future development in Rio Vista
- Increased shipping to the Port of Sacramento
- Travis AFB as military installation and as a joint use passenger/freight airport
- Preservation of Delta environment
- Location-appropriate design
- Policy mandates such as SB 375
- Integration of economic, environmental and equity concerns

DRAFT STUDY RECOMMENDATIONS


Short-term vision (Years 2015 - 2020)

- Build upon funded or completed safety improvements including:
 - Add temporary concrete barriers
 - Add temporary lane dividers
 - Reinforce the pavement to resist settlement
 - Provide shoulders in the median
 - Widen lane widths
 - Provide outside shoulders
- Provide additional concessions for agricultural traffic
- Monitor roadways and inform motorists
- Provide improvement projects in/near Rio Vista
- Upgrade movable bridge approaches

Long-term vision (Years 2020 - 2035)

- Address capacity issues along the corridor by:
 - Adding a lane in each direction through Fairfield and Suisun City
 - Constructing a 4-lane highway between State Route 113 and State Route 160
 - Replacing movable bridges at the Rio Vista and Mokelumne crossings
 - Providing shoulders in the median
 - Widening lane widths
 - Providing outside shoulders
- Enhance 2-lane highway sections with:
 - Median barriers
 - Inside shoulders
 - Widening lanes to 12'
 - Outside shoulders
- Provide acceleration lanes
