### Caltrans and Regional Transportation Agencies to hold a Community Workshop regarding the State Route 12 Corridor Study

The State Route 12 communities in Solano, San Joaquin and Sacramento counties are invited to participate in a community workshop regarding the study on Wednesday, May 16, 2012 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the D.H. White Elementary School, Multi-purpose Room, 500 Elm Way, Rio Vista, CA 94571.

This workshop is part of an ongoing collaboration between Caltrans, the Solano Transportation Authority (STA), San Joaquin Council of Governments (SJCOG), Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC), and Sacramento Council of Governments (SACOG) to improve safety and operations along the State Route 12 Corridor.


The planning process for this project began in the summer of 2010 and will be completed in June 2012. The goal of the study is to develop a multi-jurisdictional Corridor Management Plan (CMP) that includes public input on a set of short-and long-term improvement strategies for State Route 12. This study will build upon and update existing studies for the State Route 12 corridor. This busy stretch of highway is 52 miles long connecting State Route 29 and Interstate 5.



Participants in the workshop will review and discuss the **Alternative Improvement Strategies and Draft Study Recommendations**. The study includes both a short- and a long-term vision for State Route 12. Elements of these plans include recommendations for technological improvements that maximize the operation, safety, and efficiency of the roadway, as well as bridge replacements and facilities used by pedestrians, bicyclists and public transit riders.

This meeting will be one of the last opportunities for community members to provide feedback on the future corridor. Educational displays and materials will be available along with Spanish-language interpreters, donated raffle items and refreshments.
