# Public Workshop Elements

- Interactive, open house format
  - Introductory Video
  - Section Stations: one for each of the 3 sections of the CFMP
    - Each station will have:
      - Informational displays, which include large presentation boards, handouts, and a copy of that section of the plan
      - Feedback displays, where specific questions will be posed to the public in order to gauge interest, preference, or perception on several elements of the plan
  - Comment Station: a table where the public can fill out and submit comments cards
  - Each station will have a staff member to discuss the CFMP and answer questions. There will also be a Spanish language interpreter and a CT District employee to answer questions regarding local freight issues.
