

Visalia Transfer Center Detail




Western extension of Routes 6, 10 and 11

# City of Visalia Transit Division


## Dial-A-Ride

- Required by Americans with Disabilities Act
- Priority to People with Disabilities
- Must provide Comparable Service to Fixed Route
- Provides Curb to Curb Service
- Includes Picture ID with ADA Certification
- ADA Customers Make Reservations up to two Weeks

- Two Routes (Gold Red)
- Started to Address Downtown Parking
- Became Icon for the Downtown
- Free until 2008 - Added 25 cent fare
- Reduced Operation in 2013

## Sequoia Shuttle

- Cooperative agreement with National Park Service
- Includes Three Routes Inside the Park and One From Visalia
- Stops at Transit Center & Partner Hotels in Visalia/Three Rivers
- Starting our Eighth Season
- May 22 through September 1
- Five Daily Departures (6am 7am 8am 9am 10am)
- Five Returns (2:30pm 3:30pm 4:30pm 5:30pm 6:30pm)
- \$7.50 each way or \$15 Roundtrip
- Group and Early Season Discounts Available

- Product of the Gang Prevention Task Force
- Funded by the Recreation Department
- Operated by Transit Division
- Using Retired Dial-A-Ride Buses (no acquisition cost)

Currently Dispensing 85,000 Therms or 130,000 GGE



- Transit Information within Tulare County  
(877) 40 Go Green (877) 404-6473
- Allows Dispatchers to focus on more essential duties.
- Funded with Federal Funds that would have been lost to Tulare County
- Received over 6000 calls in one month
- Three FT one PT staff – Six Days a Week




