What is a CSMP?

A CSMP identifies how a travel corridor is performing, why it is performing that way, and evaluates and recommends system management strategies that best address problems.

Why do we need CSMPs?

The development of CSMPs is mandated by Nov 2006 voter approval of Proposition 1B – Corridor Mobility Improvement Account (CMIA)

CSMPs are based on the need to efficiently and effectively use all transportation modes and facilities in congested corridors so as to maximize mobility, improve safety and reduce delay costs.
