



Advancing the Value of the California Household Travel Survey (CHTS) to Caltrans




What – Advancing the Value of the California Household Travel Survey (CHTS) to Caltrans is a project that will provide Caltrans programs with valuable travel behavior data and information.

Why - There is a need for more awareness and better understanding of the CHTS data that was released in 2013.

How - The intent of this project is to instruct and familiarize Caltrans' staff in statistical applications necessary to gain a higher understanding of travel behavior data analysis. On-site interviews with staff at headquarters and selected district offices will be conducted to determine the statistical procedures needed to support Caltrans planning and project development.

Products and Services – A reference book with examples of statistical applications that analyze travel behavior data, a series of training modules and an on-call statistical consulting services.

Partners - The project is in collaboration with the UC Irvine, Institute of Transportation Studies.



Who will benefit? Caltrans programs will benefit by gaining a higher understanding of statistical applications used to analyze travel behavior. Caltrans staff can better respond to inquiry by local and regional agencies and the public.
