### RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve Relinquishment Resolution R-3514.

The local authority has been advised of the pending relinquishment a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the following summary.

R-3514 – 4-SCI-85-PM R12.0 (Request No. 56044) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Campbell, at York Avenue and Van Dusen Lane, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city streets. The City by freeway agreement dated March 15, 1988, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired March 31, 2002, without exception.
