RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve Relinquishment Resolution R-3528.

All superseded highways included in the relinquishment resolution summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authority has been advised of the pending relinquishment a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summary.

R-3528 – 6-Fre-168-KP R6.4/R14.86 (Request No. 84639) – 29 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Clovis, between Winery Avenue and the Enterprise Canal, consisting of highway right of way superseded by highway constructed on new alignment, reconstructed and relocated city streets, frontage roads, cul-de-sacs and non-motorized transportation facilities, namely pedestrian walkway. The City by cooperative agreement, dated February 24, 1999 and by letter dated June 28, 2002, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
