**SUBJECT:** Section 1202§ 135 (f)(7) Preparation of System Performance Report and Subsequent Updates for Inclusion in the Metropolitan and Statewide Planning Process

---

## **PROBLEM STATEMENT:**

Preparation of the System Performance Report and subsequent updates does not include *non-metropolitan* areas of the State.

Secondarily, incorporating this report in the development of the California Transportation Plan (CTP), which will likely include extensive collaboration with the MPOs/RTPAs, will create additional workload.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Broaden the System Performance Report for California to include all areas of the State, including non-metropolitan areas. This will require the redirection of existing or new resources to prepare the report and subsequent updates and to incorporate it into the CTP. The defined performance measures and targets will be incorporated in the California Transportation Plan (CTP) 2040, when these become available.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The performance measures and targets upon which the report will be based are projected to be adopted by March 2014.

Section 1202§ 135 (f)(7) The statewide transportation plan should include-

- The statewide transportation plan *should* include a description of the performance measures and targets used in assessing the performance of the transportation system.
- The statewide transportation plan *should* include a system performance report and subsequent updates evaluating the condition and performance of the transportation system with respect to the performance targets.

## **ALTERNATIVES:**

Pros: a) Complies and exceeds requirements of MAP-21.

b) Produces a System Performance Report that addresses all areas of the State and provides a status “check” on achieving target goals

c) Provides decision-makers a document for informed priority setting

Cons: a) Creates additional workload that would require new or redirected resources.

## **PROPOSED IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE:**

It is likely that the first System Performance Report would be issued no earlier than March 2015, as the current projection for adopted State level performance measures and targets is March 2014. Given this timeline, the System Performance Report would then be incorporated into the next CTP update in 2020 (CTP 2045).
