

List of Known Errors in the California MUTCD

Caltrans intends to correct these errors in a future revision to the California MUTCD. This list is provided solely for the information of California MUTCD users and does not constitute official changes to the California MUTCD.

<u>Page</u>	<u>Error</u>
TC2-12	Figure 2E-40 reference and its title description should be crossed out to reflect the deletion of this figure.
2B-22	In Section 2B.23, first Guidance, the reference to Figure 2B-4 should be included by changing the text to “Advance Intersection Lane Control (R3-8, R3-8a, and R3-8b) signs (see Figure 2B-4) should be used...” The deletion of the first option inadvertently also deleted the only reference to this figure that was in this section.
2B-55	In Section 2B.109(CA), the reference to “Figure 2B-101(CA)” should be corrected to “Figure 2B-106(CA)” to reflect the rearranging and renumbering of the Figures that occurred with the combined document compilation.
2C-23	In the first paragraph, reference to “Figure 2C-102(CA)” should be corrected to “Figure 2C-101(CA)” to reflect the rearranging and renumbering of the Figures that occurred with the combined document compilation.
2C-31	In Figure 2C-4(CA), the SIGNAL AHEAD Sign labeled as “W3-3a or W41A(CA)” should be “W3-3a” only since the W41A(CA) sign designation is deleted throughout the CA MUTCD and is replaced with the MUTCD W3-3a sign code designation.
2C-47	In Table 2C-101(CA) (Sheet 2 of 4), in the row for Slippery When Wet (W8-5) sign, the Section reference “2C.25” should be “2C.27”.
2C-51	In Table 2C-102(CA) (Sheet 2 of 5), in the row for Slippery When Wet (W8-5) sign, the Section reference “2C.25” should be “2C.27”.
2D-64	In Figure 2D-12, the Metric version of Traffic Signal Speed (I1-1) sign should be deleted by showing a blue X marked over the sign sketch. This sign (Metric version only) was previously deleted in the California Supplement but inadvertently was left “un-deleted” while combining and compiling the CA MUTCD.
2E-88	Figure 2E-40 should be deleted by showing a blue X marked over the figure. This figure was previously deleted in the California Supplement but inadvertently was left “un-deleted” while combining and compiling the CA MUTCD.

- 2H-9 Under second Standard, second paragraph, first sentence, the text “The requesting local agency’s...” should be changed to “The requesting local agency...”.
- 3B-6 Under Option, in second paragraph, the first sentence reference to “...~~may~~ shall ...” should be changed to “...~~may~~ shall ...” by changing the “shall” font from un-bold to bold to be consistent with the document format.
- 3B-51 In Figure 3B-12 (Sheet 3 of 3), the sign code for the THRU TRAFFIC MERGE LEFT sign should be changed from W4-1a to W4-7 in the figure as well as in Note 2, to match the MUTCD 2003 code change. The W4-1a code was per MUTCD 2000. This change was made elsewhere in the document but was inadvertently overlooked on this figure.
- 3C-6 In Table 3C-101(CA), in the last header row column title “Section” should be “California MUTCD Section” to be consistent with the other tables and their headings in the document.
- 4D-8 Under Support, sub-heading 3, the reference “Section 4D.112(CA)” should be changed to “4D.111(CA)”.
- 6C-2 Under Support, the first sentence “See Section 2B.116(CA) for more information on speed limits and zones.” should be deleted as this section no longer exists and was consolidated and incorporated into Section 2B.13. The second sentence reference to Section 2B.13 is sufficient and covers the deletion of the first sentence.
- 7B-5 In the second paragraph on this page, the first sentence should be changed to “A Speed Limit Sign Beacon also may be used, ~~with a WHEN FLASHING legend,~~ to identify the periods that the school speed limit is in effect.” This deletion of the WHEN FLASHING (S4-4) plaque is consistent with the second standard on this page which prohibits its use in School areas of California.
- 7B-16 In Table 7B-1, the row containing text for the WHEN FLASHING (S4-4) plaque should be crossed out as Section 7B.11 prohibits its use in School areas of California.
