# TCSA Conference Course Descriptions

## CA MUTCD: Signs & Markings

Johnny Bhullar - Senior Transportation Engineer ( Caltrans )

Key Topics: The class will cover recent signs and markings changes that have been included into the California MUTCD 2010 as of January 21, 2010. Compliance with the National MUTCD Revision No. 2, dealing with minimum levels of sign retro reflectivity . Sign codes, colors, shapes, symbols, borders, word messages, alphabets, sizes, heights and lateral offsets. Speed limit criteria. Warning signs advance placement distance criteria and ball band criteria for advisory speed. Street name signs. Marking colors, details , words & symbols. Centerline, laneline and edgeline marking warrants. Lane reduction transition markings. Crosswalk & parking space marking. Colored pavements.

## CA MUTCD: Overview & Updates

Johnny Bhullar - Senior Transportation Engineer ( Caltrans )

Key Topics: Format, applicability and compliance aspects of the California MUTCD . The class will cover recent changes (except for signs and markings that'll be discussed on Wed) for signals, temporary traffic control and traffic control for school areas that have been included into the California MUTCD 2010 as of January 21, 2010 in California . FHWA's recently released MUTCD 2009 and its impact on California with details on some changes that are included in it and the process involved in its adoption for California.

## ADA Compliance: Where Does Your Agency Stand? New ADA Requirements

Rocky Burks – City of Sacramento

This workshop will examine the impact that the Americans with Disabilities Act has on various public agency projects. Creating policies regarding ADA issues in the local agencies (i.e. prioritizing ADA improvements [facilities, parks, paths of travel, parking areas, etc.]). What criteria triggers ADA upgrades in construction of facilities and/or road projects? Attaining buy-in of your policies from the ADA community in your area. Suggested ideas that will keep the agency ahead of the game, avoiding potential lawsuits and court decisions on ADA -related matters. Answers to questions regarding handicap ramps, sidewalks, etc. – Some of the questions that arise involve handicap ramp improvements (as a requirement of road improvements) at areas where the street corners are offset (due to changes in street width, alignment, etc.). At some intersections, there are compliant corner ramps/sidewalks, while across the street there are no sidewalks. Is this an invitation to cross the street to an inaccessible area? Do you still construct an ADA compliant ramp connected to no sidewalk?

## PARKING LOT LAYOUT/ ADA REQUIREMENTS

Tom Ochoa - T&T Pavement Markings & Products

Come learn some tricks of the trade , see some new ideas in tools that will improve quality and efficiency in your striping jobs. Heavy emphasis will be on ADA requirements, laying out 90 and angle parking, radius striping and learning some shortcuts that will make your daily layout work easier.

## The Latest in Sign Making Technology and Fabrication

Steve Bibel – Denco Sales & Mark Faulconer - City of Clovis

Steve Bibel of Denco Sales training will consist of the following areas:

- 1) Overview on the most popular Signmaking software options: Gerber Omega & FlexiSignPro
- 2) Overview on the options for cutting and printing signage: Graphtec cutters, Mutoh and Roland printers as well as the Gerber UV flatbed printers. (Direct to substrate printing)
- 3) Demonstrate how to layout a street name sign (or custom sign) and send to the cutter or printer.
- 4) Discuss different applications that can be done with a cutter and/or printer. (Decals, banners, labels etc.)
- 5) Q & A session

Mark Faulconer, Leadworker for the City of Clovis Signs & Striping Unit will be demonstrating how they design, cut and apply materials to make street name signs as well mounting techniques to increase safety. Mark will also demonstrate how the City has used their large format printer to increase productivity and custom sign fabrication. 6" and 9" street name signs as well as Jumbo street name signs will be discussed. This portion of the class will have open discussions with sharing of information, materials used and techniques employed by the various agencies attending.

## ADVANCED AIRLESS PAINT PUMP MAINTENANCE AND SAFETY TRAINING

Presented by Roadline Products

Steve Trowbridge from Titan Speeflo will be providing a thorough overview of the hydraulic airless paint system, which will include pump safety, operation, maintenance, and repair troubleshooting.

# ATSSA Certification Course Descriptions

## Traffic Control Technician (TCT)

The one-day course provides an introduction to temporary traffic control (TTC) in a work zone for new field personnel. This course teaches concepts, techniques & practices in the installation & maintenance of traffic control devices. Includes ATSSA pocket Guide: based on the MUTCD.

To receive a certification you must successfully complete the course, have one year (2,000 hours) TTC experience, two references who can verify experience, and be approved by the ATSSA certification board.

## Traffic Control Supervisor (TCS)

The Traffic Control Supervisor course is a 2-day course designed for individuals who supervise traffic control technicians and other field personnel. It provides comprehensive training on work zone standards, guidelines, installation and removal procedures, inspection, documentation and supervisory skills.

Completion of the ATSSA Traffic Control Technician course is required as a pre-requisition to register for this course.
