## TRACON 2014 CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

### **Grinder Maintenance**

Wednesday, May 7<sup>th</sup> – 11am to 12noon Gary Winter & Arlen Stringfellow, Construction Equipment 4 Less

This training offers an overview of grinders and scarifiers relating to the removal of traffic paint, thermoplastic and tape. This session covers the maintenance of the equipment, including the selection of the correct teeth for all applications. Those who work with grinders for traffic marking removal as well as those interested in becoming more familiar with grinders will find this class very informative

### **ADA Compliance: Where Does Your Agency Stand? Sidewalks and Beyond**

Wednesday, May 7<sup>th</sup> 8am to 10am, Rocky Burks – CASp, Disability Access Consultant

This workshop will examine the impact that the Americans with Disabilities Act has on various public agency projects and new construction requirements under the ADA/ABA amendments. Creating policies regarding ADA issues in local agencies (i.e. prioritizing ADA improvements [facilities, parks, paths of travel, parking areas, etc.]). What criteria triggers ADA upgrades in construction of facilities and/or road projects? Attaining buy-in of your policies from the ADA community in your area. Suggested ideas that will keep the agency ahead of the game, avoiding potential lawsuits and court decisions on ADA-related matters. Answers to questions regarding curb ramps, sidewalks, etc. -Some of the questions that arise involve curb ramp improvements (as a requirement of road overlay vs. bonded wearing course, chip seal or slurry seal) at areas where the street corners are offset {due to changes in street width, alignment, etc.}. At some intersections, there are compliant curb ramps/sidewalks, while across the street there are no sidewalks. Is this an invitation to cross the street to an inaccessible area? Do you still construct an ADA compliant curb ramp connected to no sidewalk?

### **Thermoplastic Pavement Markings Application**

Pavement Markings-Is your agency experiencing problems with stencil thermo pavement markings? This class will answer all your questions regarding application to produce crisp high quality stencil thermo pavement markings. Experience hands on application from subject matter experts.

## **ATSSA Certification Grant Course Descriptions**

### **Traffic Control Technician (TCT)**

Tuesday, May 6<sup>th</sup> – 8:00am to 5:00pm

The one-day course provides an introduction to temporary traffic control (TTC) in a work zone for new field personnel. This course teaches concepts, techniques & practices in the installation & maintenance of traffic control devices. Includes ATSSA pocket Guide: based on the MUTCD.

To receive a certification you must successfully complete the course, have one year (2,000 hours) TTC experience, two references who can verify experience, and be approved by the ATSSA certification board.

### **Traffic Control Supervisor (TCS)**

Wednesday, May 7<sup>th</sup> – 8:00 am to 5:00 pm (part 1)

Thursday, May 8<sup>th</sup> – 8:00 am to 5:00 pm (part 2)

The Traffic Control Supervisor course is a 2-day course designed for individuals who supervise traffic control technicians and other field personnel. It provides comprehensive training on work zone standards, guidelines, installation and removal procedures, inspection, documentation and supervisory skills.

**Completion of the ATSSA Traffic Control Technician course is required as a pre-requisition to register for this course.**

### **ITS Berkeley – Tech Transfer Training**

### **TS-10 TRAFFIC CONTROL FOR SAFER WORK ZONES**

Tech Transfer provides Cal-OSHA-compliant work zone safety training for work zone crews. This course on Traffic Control for Safe Work Zones is designed to meet the dynamic needs of those constructing and maintaining roads in California. The course incorporates the latest State and Federal guidelines relevant to roadway construction and maintenance work done by cities, counties, state and federal agencies, utility companies and private contractors. The course covers the basics of work zone traffic control and some flagger training. The sections on setting up traffic control plans and flagger training may be modified to suit the needs of the trainees in a particular location.

- Traffic control plans for various types of roadway situations encountered in cities and counties in California
- Instruction on proper flagging procedures
- Legal section on work zone tort liability
